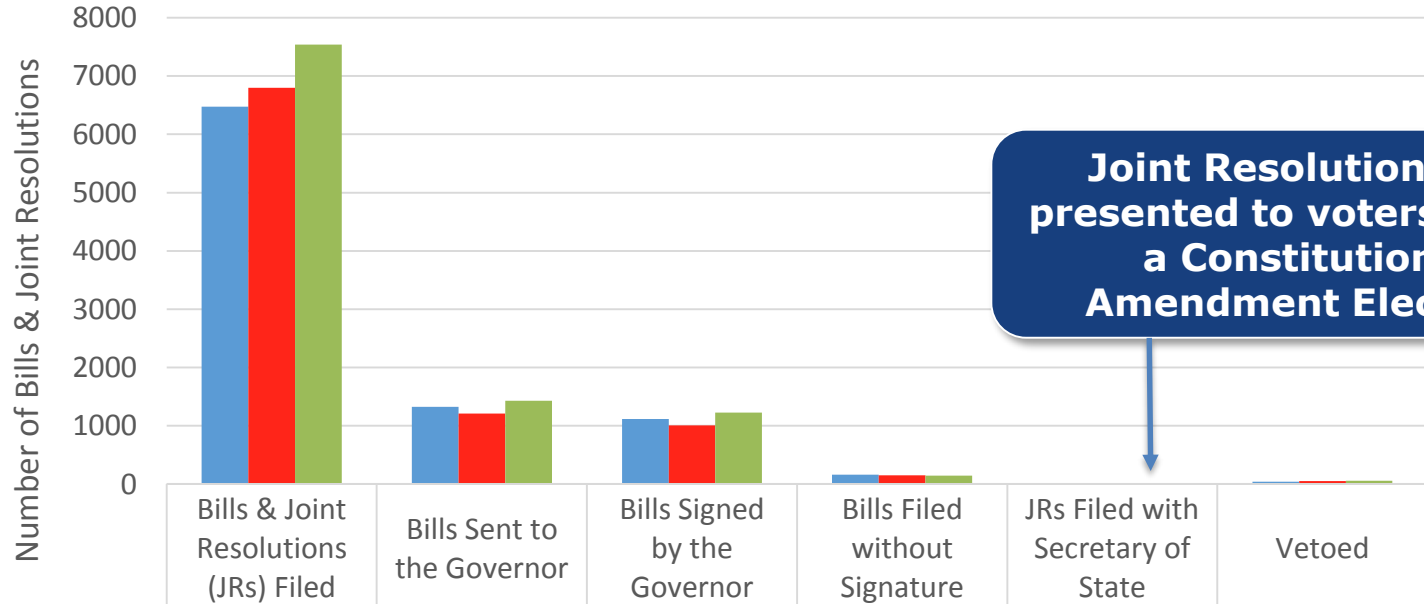

BILL STATISTICS

84th Legislature (2015)	6476	1323	1117	163	7	41

CPS Energy tracked over 560 bills and joint resolutions, of which 110 passed.

CPS ENERGY PRIORITIES



House Bill 61 - Utility Worker Safety

- Beginning 9/1/2019, utility vehicles (electric, gas, water, etc.) will be added to the Texas Move Over/Slow Down law.
- Successful collaboration across a number of industry and legislative counterparts to support HB 61 and other bills filed to add utility vehicles to the protections of the law.
